Montgomery stated that the meeting was called to determine if Williams County would assume the operations of the Department of Motor Vehicle – Williston Branch. Williston State College Foundation could not renew the agreement with NDDOT (North Dakota Department of Transportation). Both Williams County and the City of Williston were approached to take over operations. It was believed that the employee benefits were more in line with Williams County than the City.

It was stated that DMV Williston Branch are revenue neutral and self-sustaining.
