Public Information Meeting about 1% Public Safety Sales Tax in Williston

Williston, N.D., (Oct. 6, 2014) – On Thursday, October 16 officials from both Williams County and the City of Williston will hold one of many public information meetings across the county regarding the 1% sales tax that is on the ballot for elections this November 4. The meeting is from 7-8:30pm in the Williston Public Library and is open to all who are interested in attending.

The meeting will introduce the public safety sales tax, providing background and reasoning behind the county's decision to put the tax up for a vote on this November ballot. Representatives from Williams County, City of Williston, and potentially benefitting agencies will be in attendance to present their perspective on the tax. After the informational portion there will be a portion of time allotted for the public to pose questions to the panel.
