Williams County Landowner,

According to State Law, landowners are required to control the spread of noxious weeds due to the potential for millions of dollars in damage to North Dakota crops and forage.

Landowners that fail to control the spread of Noxious weeds on their property shall be notified and/or sprayed by the county and the cost assessed to the landowner.

To aid landowners in this fight to control Noxious weeds, the County Weed Board offers a cost share program on the purchase of needed herbicides to combat specific weeds.

We encourage landowners to either spray the Noxious weeds or hire a custom applicator to do it for them, as the timeframe is often narrow to effectively spray.

If the County is required to spray, the Weed Board has approved the following costs for equipment, in addition to herbicide cost:

The UTV rate is at \$60.00 per hour.

The truck rate is \$80.00 per day.

These rates are set to encourage landowners to be actively involved in their own land management.
