Williston, N.D., (September 11, 2019) – On September 10, 2019 at approximately 5:49 pm, Williams County Deputies attempted to stop a Honda Accord at the Highway 85 Bypass and 52nd St NW due to suspected criminal mischief and criminal trespass. The vehicle would not stop. Deputies continued behind the vehicle while displaying emergency lights and sounding their sirens. Spike strips were deployed and the vehicle came stop the area of 29th St W and 29th Ave W. in the city of Williston. The suspect would not exit the vehicle despite Deputies' commands. Less lethal bean bag rounds were fired through the passenger side window of the Honda. The suspect exited the vehicle and was arrested. No injuries were sustained by the suspect or Deputies. During this pursuit, speeds did not exceed 30 mile per hour. This was an isolated incident and the public was not in any sort of danger.

The suspect is being charged with Fleeing in a Motor Vehicle-C felony, Reckless Driving-B misdemeanor and Driving under Suspension-B misdemeanor. More charges are likely to come.

The suspect is 32 year old Daniel Tyler Erickson of Williston.
