Williston, N.D., (September 23, 2019) – On September 21, 2019, at approximately 4:00 a.m., Deputies from the Williams County Sheriff's Office were called to 119 4th Ave East in Ray for a burglary complaint. Upon arrival, Deputies were informed that Juan Olguin had broken into the home of his ex-girlfriend. Olguin threatened to kill her, stole some tools, and then left the residence. It was later discovered that someone broke into her vehicle as well.

That same morning at approximately 4:50 a.m., Deputies arrested Olguin behind the Grand Williston Hotel in Williston. Olguin was transported to the Williams County Correctional Center and is being held for Terrorizing (C Felony) and Burglary (B Felony) with no bond set at this time.
