Williston, N.D., (October 15, 2019) – In relation to recent storage unit break-ins, the Williams County Sheriff's Office and the Williston Police Department executed a search warrant in the 3200 block of 22nd Ave West in Williston on October 11, 2019.

During the search warrant, Andrew Morris, Amanda Neer, and Cheyenne Tawney ran from law enforcement. Morris was apprehended on the road. Neer and Tawney ran into an unknown person's apartment where they were later apprehended.

Multiple stolen items were recovered with the search warrant.

Forty-two year old Andrew Morris has been charged with Burglary (C Felony), Theft of Property (C Felony), Possession of Stolen Property (C Felony), Unlawful Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (C Felony), 2 counts of Unlawful Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (A Misdemeanor), and Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance (A Misdemeanor).

Twenty-eight year old Amanda Neer has been charged with 2 counts of Unlawful Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (A Misdemeanor), Possession of Stolen Property (C Felony), Criminal Trespass (C Felony).

Twenty-three year old Cheyenne Tawney has been charged with Unlawful Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (A Misdemeanor) and Criminal Trespass (C Felony).

The investigation is ongoing. The public is encouraged to periodically check their storage units and locks. Thank you.
