**Williams County Planning and Zoning Commission to hear landfill application for disposal of TENORM**

**Williston, N.D., (September 13, 2019)** – The Williams County Planning and Zoning Division has received an application from Secure Energy Services USA, LLC for an amendment to the Conditional Use Permit for the Thirteen Mile Special Waste Landfill. The amendment to the Conditional Use Permit would allow the landfill to dispose of Technologically Enhanced Naturally Occurring Radioactive Material (TENORM).

The application will be reviewed by the Williams County Planning and Zoning Commission during their regular meeting on Thursday, October 17, 2019, at 6:00 pm in the Williams County Commission Room (206 Broadway, lower level) and a public hearing will be held.

Due to questions from citizens and the recent media attention, Williams County would like to ensure that residents are aware that Planning and Zoning Commission meetings are public, and that public comments are accepted.
