

ZERO TOLERANCE FOR SEXUAL ABUSE AND SEXUAL HARASSMENT

RIGHT TO REPORT

If you, or someone you know, are experiencing sexual abuse or sexual harassment, The Williams County Sheriff's Office wants to know. We want you to report right away! Why?

- **We want to keep YOU safe;** it is our job! It is your right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment.
- We want to conduct an investigation of the reported incident.
- We want to hold the perpetrator accountable for his/her actions.
- We want to provide YOU with relevant information and support services.

HOW TO REPORT

The Williams County Sheriff's Office offers multiple ways to report sexual abuse and sexual harassment. Reports can be made anonymously.

- Call the National Sexual Assault Hotline at **1-800-656-4673**.
- Report to any staff, volunteer, contractor, or medical or mental health staff.
- Submit a grievance or a sick call slip.
- Report to the PREA coordinator: PREACoordinator@co.williams.nd.us
- Tell a family member, friend, legal counsel, or anyone else outside the facility. They can report on your behalf by calling **1-800-656-4673**.
- You also can submit a report on someone's behalf, or someone at the facility can report for you by mailing to:
